We have children on Whatsapp groups, Snapchat, Tik Tok, creating Youtube Channels, and gaming online. The age guidance for all of these is well above Primary age.

This has and continues to lead to language deterioration, aggression, strangers being on groups whose age is unknown, talking to the children, targeting by older people, locations being left on and children being able to be tracked, and bullying regularly on group chats. It is an issue that is not going away but as parents we are responsible for their safety and health, therefore we are responsible for their online use. Please check their devices.
